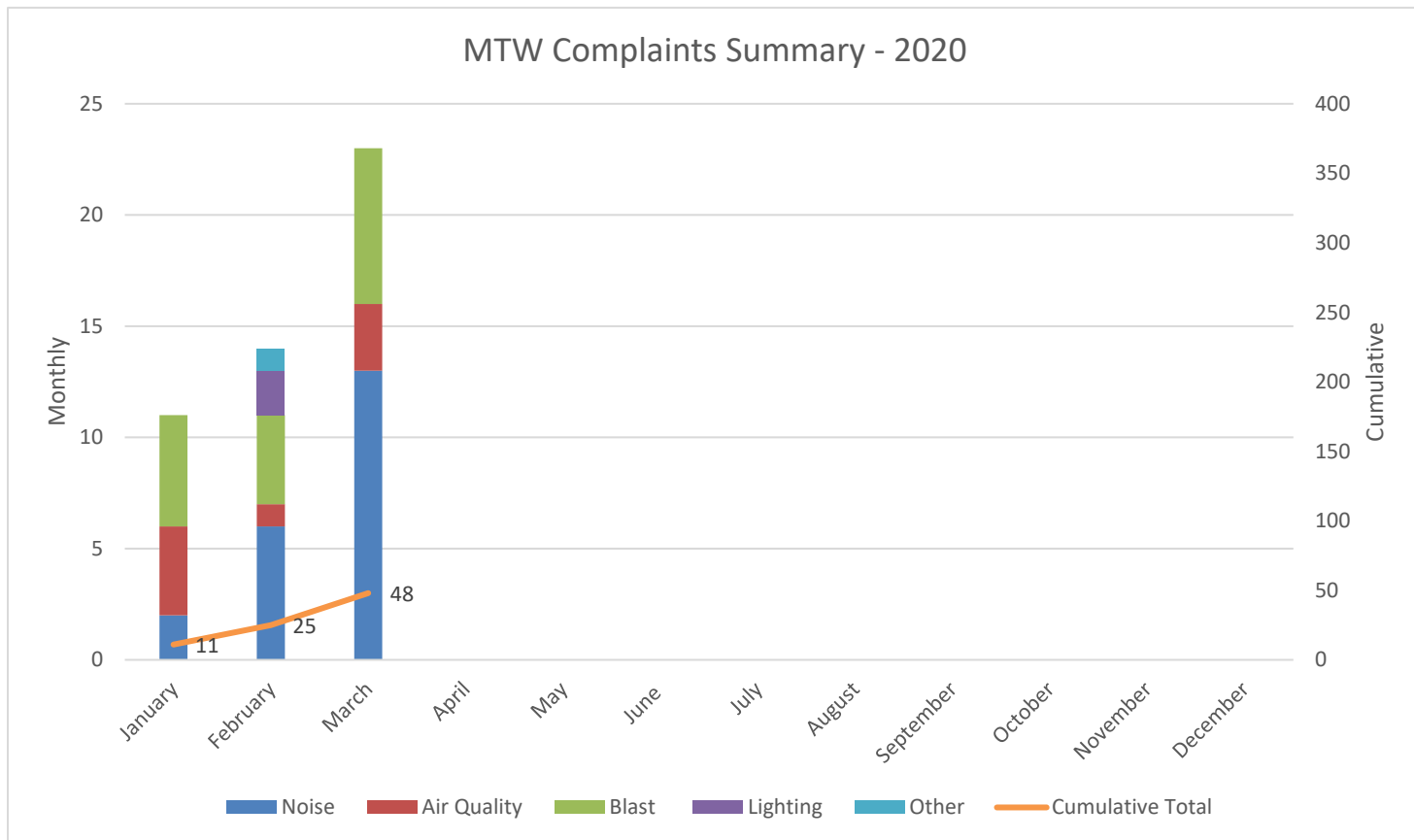

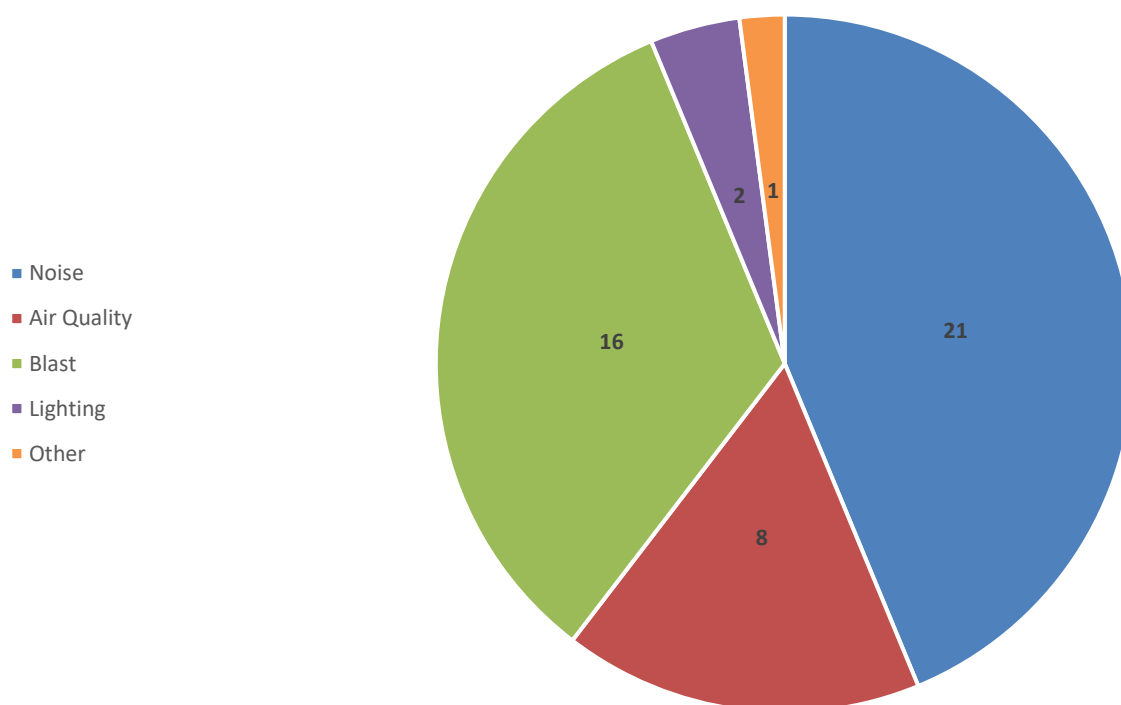

### Complaints overview for period – 1 January 2020 to 31 March 2020



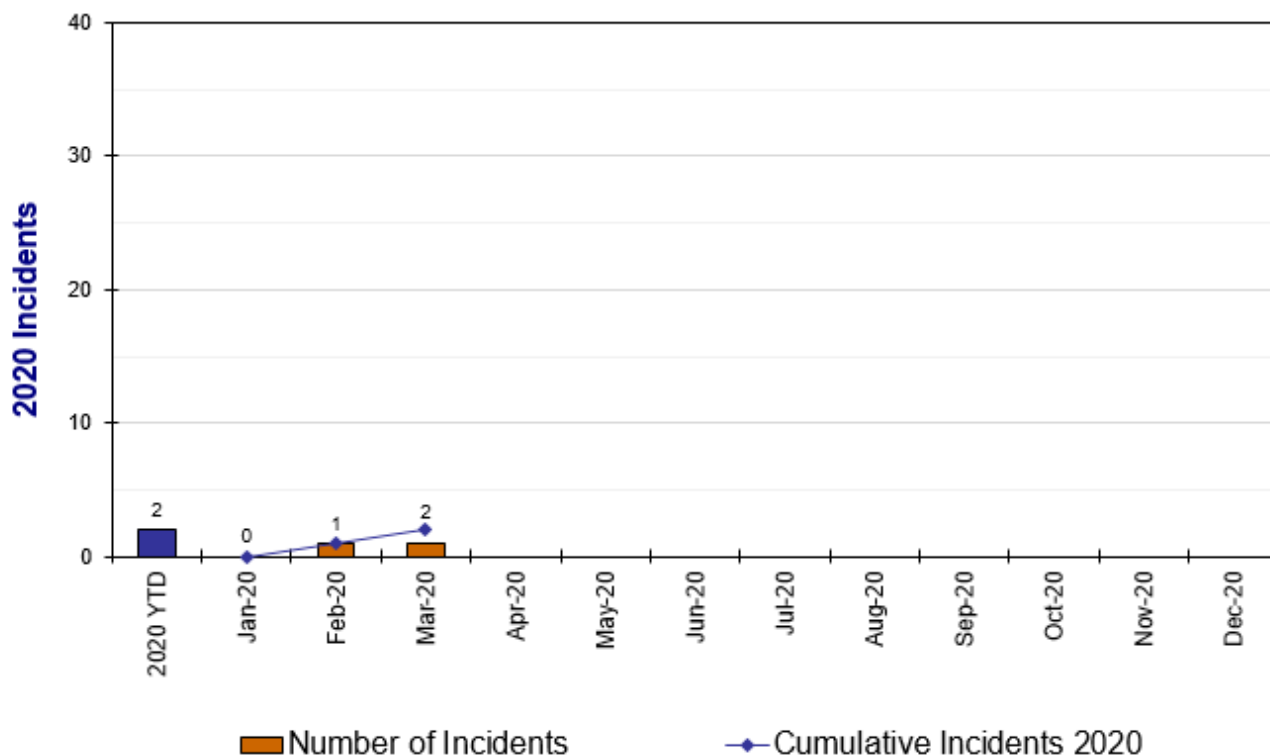
### Complaints by Type 2020

#### Incident Summary for the period 1 January 2020 to 31 March 2020

Date	Details	Key Actions	Aspect
9/02/2020	Overtopping of Warkworth sediment dams 53N and 50N due to greater than design rainfall	The Pollution Incident Response Management Plan (PIRMP) was initiated by the Environment and Community Manager, with external notifications made to the relevant regulatory authorities in accordance with the PIRMP. Water quality sampling was undertaken at Dam 50N and Dam 53N. Dams were dewatered during and after rainfall in readiness for future rainfall events. Written reports were provided to EPA, DPIE, and DPIE-RR. DPIE and EPA have advised that no action will be taken.	Surface Water

Date	Details	Key Actions	Aspect
16/03/2020	Breach of Ground Disturbance Permit Conditions (GDP 136) resulting in clearing outside of the approved area identified in the GDP for an exploration access track.	The cleared area was assessed, with the findings indicating that there was no cultural heritage sites or habitat features in the cleared area. The area is approved for future clearing for mining. Process improvements have been identified with site teams to prevent reoccurrence.	Ground Disturbance

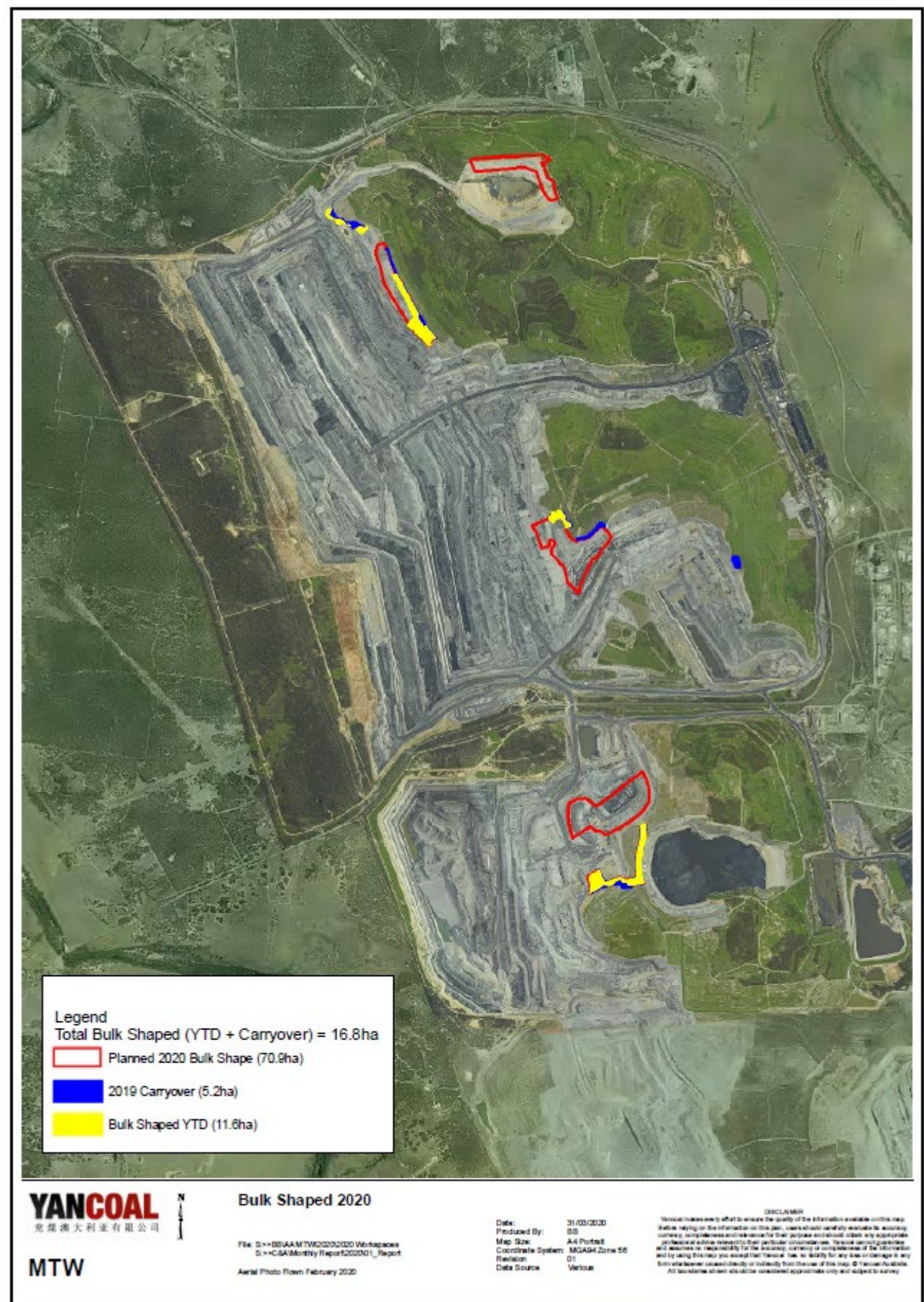
## **4 REHABILITATION PLAN**

The rehabilitation target for 2020 is 64ha and the planned total disturbance is 60ha, which includes 3.3ha of rehabilitation disturbance to upgrade a light vehicle access road from the North ROM area to North Pit North.

At the end of April there was 7ha of rehabilitation area ready to seed, having been spread with soil ameliorants (compost and gypsum). There is a further 11.1ha that has been bulk shaped in preparation for the later stages of rehabilitation.

Disturbance completed to the end of April totals 2.5ha and is mainly associated with clearing ahead of mining in West Pit.
